



Guess Which Year

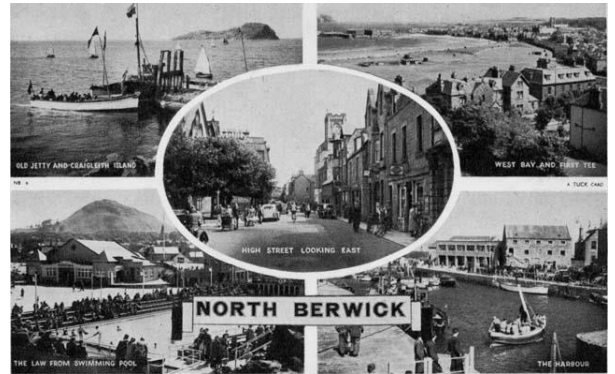


By using the clues and photos featured below, can you guess which year it is?
